Welcome to the Australian Government's Capacity Investment Scheme Tender 10: National Electricity Market – Dispatchable Capacity (**Tender 10, Tender Process** or **Tender 10 Process**), conducted by AEMO. Registration is now open.

All references to 'you' or 'Proponent' in this Registration Form refer to any Proponent and their Bid Entity, as defined in the CIS Tender 10 NEM Dispatchable Capacity Tender Guidelines (**Tender Guidelines**). This Registration Form should be read together with the Tender Guidelines and, to the extent of any inconsistency, the Tender Guidelines will prevail.

Participation in Tender 10

Participation in Tender 10 involves two sequential steps:

1. **Registration:** Complete and submit this Registration Form to register your Project prior to submitting a Bid. The purpose of registration is to provide indicative Project and Proponent details, identify authorised contacts, and indicate the product(s) intended for inclusion in the Bid.
2. **Bid submission:** Access to the CIS Tender 10 Bid Form will be granted to registered Proponents. The Bid Form must be submitted along with the required Returnable Schedules, attachments and other information necessary to demonstrate satisfaction of each of the Eligibility Criteria (**EC**), Merit Criteria (**MC**) and ability and preparedness to meet the requirements of all applicable Project Documents.

Registration requirements

Proponents may only register and submit one Bid per Project. Proponents must not submit a Duplicative Bid. A Bid will be considered a Duplicative Bid if, as described in Section 5.2.2 of the Tender Guidelines, it is in respect of essentially the same Project as another Bid from the same Proponent or its Associates, and only has changes to the configuration or design (such as Registered Capacity). If a Proponent submits Bids that are considered by AEMO to be Duplicative Bids, AEMO will accept the compliant Bid that was submitted last, and any other Bids will be rejected. In the case of Aggregated Projects, if any Project Components appear in more than one Bid, the compliant Bid that was submitted last will be accepted and any other Bids containing that Project Component will be rejected.

Proponents must register a SmartyFile account to complete this Registration Form. Proponents that have created a SmartyFile organisation profile may assign multiple team members as users for their organisation with different access levels, enabling collaboration on submissions. 1.2 Information Commercial-in-confidence

AEMO and/or the Australian Government will retain all information provided by you and may, at any time, copy and distribute the information for the purposes of designing, facilitating and conducting the Tender Process, including negotiation and evaluation of Bids, and to support their due diligence and strategic risk assessment. Information will otherwise be treated as confidential and will not be disclosed outside AEMO or the Australian Government, unless that disclosure is:

- 1.required or permitted by Law to be made, or made in the course of legal proceedings;
- 2.of information that is publicly available, or becomes publicly available other than through a breach of this provision;
- 3.of de-identified information disclosed in the public interest for the purposes of informing the market of tender outcomes including (but not limited to):

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- the number of Bids received and the average number of Bids per Proponent;
- scoring results across each Merit Criterion or price from Bids, including as they may delineate successful and unsuccessful Bids; or
- graphical or numerical information on any aspect of a Bid or the Bid evaluation;

- 1.requested by any Authority that has jurisdiction over the Australian Government, AEMO or its or their activities;
- 2.requested by any relevant Commonwealth Ministers or their advisers, any relevant parliament, parliamentary committee, ombudsman or anti-corruption commission (or similar body in any jurisdiction);
- 3.required to be made by AEMO or the Australian Government when, in order to conduct due diligence, they contact a relevant Australian Government, State or Territory Government or other relevant parties, including the Consumer Trustee, EnergyCo, or

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- the Scheme Administrator of the South Australian Firm Energy Reliability Mechanism, about a Bid, Project or Proponent;

1.3 Use of Information

Without limitation to the rights granted in Section 6.9 and Section 6.20 of the Tender Guidelines, the Proponent grants, and must ensure that each of its relevant Associates grant, to AEMO and the Australian Government, and any entities or persons assisting AEMO or the Australian Government with the evaluation of Bids, an irrevocable, perpetual, non-exclusive, transferable, worldwide, free-of-charge licence to use, reproduce, develop, communicate, modify and/or sub-license the whole or any part of any Information for the purposes of:
